Falmouth

Falmouth does not have its own airport, but you can fly to Exeter (EXT) or Bristol in an hour and a half and continue by bus and train.

To the train station in Exeter (St. Davids Station)

Bus

With bus 56 'South West' you can get to the train station of Exeter (St David's) in half an hour, this costs about £ 3. See www.stagecoachbus.com (from Exeter Airport to Exeter St David's).

Ticket can be purchased in the bus. The bus stops directly in front of the train station, where you can also find a Starbucks.

Taxi

Approximately 12 km by taxi in 25 minutes.

Train to 'Falmouth town'

From St David's you can catch the train to Falmouth Town, for about € 26, - train ticket can be purchased at the counter, or online in advance. Plan your route here: www.thetrainline.com

Depending on your arrival time, the time to travel to Falmouth is between 3.5 and 4.5 hours, with 1 or 2 transfers, in any case at the small station of Truro.

From 'Falmouth Town' Railway Station it is an 11-minute walk to the marina. You can also take bus 366 to the 'Church Corner' stop, which runs every half hour and from there it will be a 4 minute walk to the boat.

Bus Alternative from Falmouth to Exeter

The Mega bus, which runs once or twice a day, starting at £ 3. Travel time is a little over 4 hours with only one transfer. Seems very beneficial for the return trip to Exeter:
