To the train station in Exeter (St. Davids Station)

Bus

With bus 56 'South West' you can get to the train station of Exeter (St David's) in half an hour, this costs about £ 3. See www.stagecoachbus.com (from Exeter Airport to Exeter St David's).

Ticket can be purchased in the bus. The bus stops directly in front of the train station, where you can also find a Starbucks.

Taxi

Approximately 12 km by taxi in 25 minutes.

Train to Torquay

From St David's you can catch the train to Torquay in 40 minutes, for about € 10, - train ticket can be purchased at the counter, or online in advance. Plan your route here: www.thetrainline.com

From the railway Station it is an 20-minute walk to the marina. Or 5 minutes with the taxi. You can also take the bus, 'stagecoach Gold' 12, from stand 'Grand Hotel' to 'Cary Parade' in 13 minutes. This bus runs every half hour and from there it will be a 9 minute walk to the boat.
